

## PLANNING BOARD

OCTOBER 1, 2020

The meeting was called to order by Chairman LaFurney with the Pledge of Allegiance at 7:00 PM. Attending were Chairman LaFurney, Vice Chairman Carmen Papa, Tony Murabito, Mike Sullivan, Diane Miano, and Chuck Thomas.

The minutes of the September meeting were accepted as read by Carman Papa second- Chuck Thomas. All in favor.

A motion was made to open the Public Hearing for Dario Stipisic minor subdivision by Chairman LaFurney. There was no one present in the audience to discuss this matter. The Public Hearing stayed open and the board commenced with other business.

CORRESPONDENCE- A letter was received from Carl Emmons Jr, Code Enforcement, regarding the W D Malone Muck Road mine. Code Enforcement states there is no problems with the mining permit and operation.

OLD BUSINESS and Public Hearing- Mr. Stipisic needs to furnish the board 7 full size Plats and 1 Mylar to be stamped and signed. He also needs to provide signed authorization to an individual to process the paperwork with Oswego County. The final approval was placed on hold for the required paperwork. A motion was made by Diane Miano – second Carmen Papa to close the public hearing at 7:31 PM. All in favor.

NEW BUSINESS- Linda Lyons of Peat Bed Road was present tonight , with neighbor Paulette Pannozzo, to discuss the need of a area variance to replace a burned out garage with a 24' x 24" movable shed which would be placed 8 foot from the property line. She produced letters from both neighbors stating they had no problems with the placement of the shed. The board will wait for Carl Emmons written approval. Carmen would like to look up all the particulars before the Planning Board makes any decisions. Mike Fogel, Attorney for W D Malone, was

present tonight to highlight all points of the mine permit. We have received the necessary application and all the DEC paperwork. A motion was made by Carmen Papa- second Chuck Thomas to have a Public Hearing November 5, 2020. All in favor. Chairman LaFurney asked Mr. Fogel to check with W D Malone on the average number of trucks in a 30 day period that traveled to and from the Harris Hill Road mine. "Just for information". Heather Ladd was in attendance tonight to observe the meeting. A motion was made by Chairman LaFurney- second Carmen Papa to create a subcommittee to create a job description for the Planning Board Secretary. The subcommittee will be Mike LaFurney, Carmen Papa and Diane Miano. Carmen Papa also suggested he would like the audio minutes emailed to all board members after the meetings. The feasibility of this will be checked.

A motion was made at 7:38 PM by Carmen Papa- second Chuck Thomas to adjourn the meeting. All in favor.
