Town of Hannibal Cemetery

Rules and Regulations for Lot Owners

- 1. Cemetery will be open for visitors from 8:00 am to sunset.
- 2. All lots are to be used for the burial of the human dead only.
- 3. No lot owner shall allow an interment to be made upon his or her lot, except by direct arrangement with the trustee of the cemetery.
- 4. No transfer or assignment of any lot or interest therein will be valid without consent in writing from the cemetery trustee. All requests will require a minimum \$50.00 service charge.
- 5. No enclosures of lots will be permitted
- 6. All corner markers must be purchased from and installed by the cemetery.
- 7. No planting allowed
- 8. Cut flowers and urns with live plants or artificial flowers are allowed. They should be placed as close to the stone as possible. That said,
 - The cemetery is not responsible for broken, stolen, tipped, or displaced items of any kind. We reserve the right to remove and discard any such items that are damaged or pose a hazard during mowing.
- 9. No glass is permitted in the cemetery.
- 10. If for any reason trees or shrubs located on a lot shall impede the operations of the cemetery, we reserve the right to correct the difficulty according to our judgment.
- 11. All work done to the cemetery is to be done only by authorized personnel.
- 12. Burial vaults used for interments are required to be either concrete or steel. Fiberglass or plastic vaults are not allowed.
- 13. All lots are subject to the rules of the cemetery and its future amendments.
- 14. Interment of cremated remains are required to be placed in an urn vault, one that is non-biodegradable, non-corrosive and uncrushable.
