SECTION 1: TITLE

This shall be known as Local Law 1 of the year 2022, a local law to amend Local Law No. 2 of 2007, amending the ATV Road Use Local Law for the Town of Hannibal.

SECTION 2: PURPOSE

The purpose of this Local Law is to designate certain town roads in the Town of Hannibal as open for travel by all-terrain vehicles (ATVs) because it has been determined by the Town Board of Hannibal that it is otherwise impossible for ATVs to gain access to areas or trails adjacent to such town roads.

SECTION 3: AUTHORITY

This Local Law is adopted pursuant to the authority contained in New York State Highway Law Section 24050.

SECTION 4: DESIGNATED ROADS

1. The following portions of town roads are hereby designated as open for travel by ATVs.
 - a. Carter Road from its intersection with Pollard Road westerly to its intersection with Stock Road
 - b. Stock Road from its intersection with Carter Road westerly to its intersection with State Route 104
 - c. Oswego Street from State Route 104 southwesterly a distance of 287 feet
 - d. Wiltsieville Road from Crandall Road intersection to Woodruff Road at Ormsby Ironworks
 - e. 2/10 mile of Onionville Road from Sixty-Six Road
 - f. Rochester Street from Village line to intersection with Sixty-Six Road
 - g. Sixty-Six Road from intersection with Rochester Street to Onionville Road
 - h. Mills Street from Village line to intersection with Blythe Road
 - i. Blythe Road from intersection with Mill Street to Wiltsieville Road
 - j. Wiltsieville Road from intersection with Blythe Road to Crandall Road
2. All individuals traveling upon ATVs on roads designated herein shall comply with the following rules and regulations.
 - a. All regulations of New York concerning the operation, registration and inspection and insuring of ATVs shall be followed.
 - b. A maximum speed limit of 30 miles per hour shall be observed.
 - c. ATVs shall not be operated on the designated roads between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m.
 - d. ATVs shall be no louder than if equipped with stock mufflers.
 - e. Vehicle and Traffic Law regulations concerning driving while under the influence of alcohol or drugs shall be complied with.
 - f. All operators of ATVs on the designated roads shall be at least sixteen years of age.

SECTION 6: EFFECTIVE DATE

This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Department of State.

SECTION 7: REPEALER

This Local Law shall supersede Local Laws No. 1 of 2006, Local Law No. 2 of 2007 and Local Law No. 1 of 2009 on ATV Road Use within the Town of Hannibal.
