**Approval of the February 2023 Board Meeting Minutes:**

**Old Business:**

- The Planning Board still has one vacant seat, the ZBA has two open seats and the BAR has one unfilled seat. As discussed above, two letters of interest have been received.
- The Board discussed the use of ARPA Funds for the following:
  - a) Frisbee Golf Course - more information is needed on the use of the property behind the Municipal Building/Water Tower, on maintenance of the course such as monthly mowing of the property, having a carry in/carry out policy for trash, etc.
  - b) Improvements to the Skate Park – ramp needs repair, pavement needs sealing, etc.
  - c) Waterless Restroom – still looking at prices
  - d) Bulk Water Project – different options to consider were discussed, such as self-serve payment options and remaining open year round (frost free option).
- The Board discussed the need for people to serve on the Comprehensive Plan Committee and that the Town Board, Village Board, and Planning Board members could offer their input but the final decisions would be made by the core members of the Comprehensive Plan Committee.

- The Board discussed offering a tax exemption to volunteer firefighters and volunteer ambulance workers. It was suggested that the template that is available from the Association of Towns website be sent to the Town Attorney to review it. Councilman Greg Hilton made a motion to approve the following resolution; seconded by Councilman Andrew Holden.

**Resolution 25 -2023**

**BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Hannibal Town Board approves to send the template on offering a tax exemption to volunteer firefighters and volunteer ambulance workers to the Town Attorney to review.**
