

What is ACCESS Oswego?

ACCESS Oswego is a curb to curb transportation service for the general public, elderly, and persons with special needs in Oswego County. Service is only available when other public transportation is not readily available in your area. This service can be used for medical, social, or personal business.

THINGS YOU SHOULD KNOW

Persons in need of assistance from their home to the bus should request assistance at the time of reservation.

Persons in need of an attendant while at doctor's appointments etc. Are responsible for providing their own attendant.

It is very important that you are ready for pickup at least 30 minutes before the scheduled pickup time.

RESERVATIONS & CANCELLATIONS

- Reservations need to be called in 2 business days in advance.
Less than 2 days may be considered.
- Cancellations must be called in at least 2 hours before scheduled pickup.
