SECTION 1. TITLE

This shall be known as Local Law 1 of the year 2023, a local law providing for a partial real property tax exemption for Volunteer Firefighters within the Town of Hannibal.

SECTION 2. PURPOSE AND INTENT

It is the intent of the Town Board of the Town of Hannibal, County of Oswego, to provide a real property tax exemption to qualifying volunteer firefighters as set forth in Real Property Tax Law §466-a.

SECTION 3. AUTHORITY

Real Property Tax Law §466-a authorizes the Town Board to adopt a local law providing a real property tax exemption of up to ten percent of the assessed value of real property owned by qualifying volunteer firefighters.

SECTION 4. GRANT OF REAL PROPERTY TAX EXEMPTION FOR VOLUNTEER FIREFIGHTERS

The Town Board of the Town of Hannibal, County of Oswego, hereby provides a real property tax exemption of 10% of the assessed value of real property for individuals that meet the following qualifications:

- a. The individual is an enrolled and certified member of an incorporated volunteer fire company or fire department that serves the Town of Hannibal and has a minimum of two years of service; and
- b. The individual resides in the Town and the property receiving the benefit is the primary residence of the individual and is used exclusively for residential purposes, and any portion of the property not used for residential purposes shall be subject to taxation.

SECTION 5. GRANT OF LIFETIME REAL PROPERTY TAX EXEMPTION FOR CERTAIN VOLUNTEER FIREFIGHTERS

The Town Board of the Town of Hannibal, County of Oswego, hereby provides a lifetime real property tax exemption of 10% of the assessed value of real property for any individuals that have been certified by the authority having jurisdiction over an incorporated volunteer fire company or fire department as having accrued twenty or more years of active service, so long as their primary residence remains within the Town of Hannibal.

SECTION 6. SEVERABILITY

If any clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision or part of this local law or the application thereof to any person, firm or corporation, or circumstance, shall be adjusted by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unconstitutional, such order or judgment shall not affect, impair, or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in this operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, or part of this local law or in its application to the person, individual, firm or corporation or circumstance, directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment or order shall be rendered.

SECTION 7. EFFECTIVE DATE

This local law shall be effective immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.
