SUBJECT: Winter Roads Notification

To: Town of Hannibal Residents,

The winter season is upon us and I am requesting that all personal property such as cars, boats, basketball hoops, fencing, rocks, etc. be removed from the Town roads and Town-right-of-way (ROW) which is 25 feet from the center of the road. Objects in the ROW are in danger of being damaged and /or causing damage to Town owned equipment. Your items damaged by the Town in the process of snow or ice removal will NOT be replaced by the Town. If such items damage Town equipment you will be charged for the cost of repairs or replacement.

During the period of November 1 through April 1 no person shall stop, stand or park any vehicle, whether occupied or not on the pavement or shoulder of any and all Town roads or streets. Any Violation of this Law is subject to a penalty up to \$100 and /or removal of the vehicle at the owner's expense. If there is an emergency and a vehicle is obstructing our route it will be removed without notice.

Also, we are asking for your cooperation in compliance with Highway Law # 214. This law states it is illegal to deposit snow & ice on Town roads. The snow can refreeze creating a hazard for all motorists. The benefit is fewer trips for us, less snow put back into your driveway, and less shoveling for you. Your consideration is appreciated. Also, please know we do not purposefully put snow in your driveway. Snow will follow the path of least resistance and when an opening from banks comes up unfortunately, the snow will be deposited in that opening.
